Dear Parents and Guardians

It is with great pleasure that we are ready to launch this year's Activity Week. Activity Week 2020 is the week of **13 July to 17 July 2020**. Staff have started to plan exciting trips and activities for this week.

We are now in a position where we need some indication of numbers of students interested in the residential trips (two in the UK, two abroad). Information will follow on school based activities. Some will incur a small cost whilst others will be free. Information about these activities will be given out once we have numbers for the residential. Please note if your child decides to participate in a 3 day residential, they will also need to sign up for two days of activities based at school. This will be done at a later date.

Please could you discuss the information with your child and **indicate** which option your child would like to do. Please note that if your child would like to take part in one of the residential trips a **non-returnable deposit of £50 would need to be paid by Monday 14 October. A letter will come out to prompt this payment when we have agreed numbers.** The rest of the payment would then be spread across the year, with a final payment due by the close of the spring term.

We require this information quite quickly so we can confirm bookings with the relevant companies. Please could your child return their reply slip to their reception no later than **Thursday 3 October. Please do not send any money in at this stage**, we only need to know initial interest. Once we have a clear picture of which activities the students want to take part in, further information will be given out with full details of the activities and payment plans.

Please note that Year 10 students will have the option of doing a work experience week during Activities Week that they will have to organise themselves (in liaison with the school).
