## Re: Year 11 Prom 2020

I would just like to take this opportunity to reassure students, parents and carers that there will be a Year 11 Prom organised by the school for the class of 2020. The Prom will be held at The Moat House in Acton Trussell on 3 July 2020.

All students at this point are invited to attend the Prom and ticket sales will go on sale in March 2020. In order to be able to purchase a ticket the student must have an attendance of 95% and over at the time the tickets go on sale. Good attendance is vital for all students particularly Year 11 who will be embarking on their GCSE in a years' time. The only exception to this are legitimate medical reasons that can be confirmed by our Attendance Officer Mrs Herrington. In order to keep this record up to date – any medical appointments must be sent in to Mrs Herrington. Any student who has an attendance of 100% will have their ticket paid for by the school and any student with an attendance of 98% will get the ticket half price.

The Prom is a reward for student's good attendance but also their positive attitude to their learning, as stressed, Year 11 is a vital year and exemplary behaviour and dedication to their studies must be demonstrated. Therefore, the decision has been made that any student who receives an exclusion in Year 11 will not be eligible to attend the Prom. Further to this any student who has repeated time in refocus will also not be eligible to attend.

The Prom is a great opportunity for students to celebrate the end of their exams but also to celebrate the end of their compulsory education as a group of young people before they move on to the next stages in their life. In order to avoid disappoint in a years' time we stress the importance of the attendance and behaviour criteria we have set out in order to attend.
